- Independence Day and Republic Day Celebrations: Flag Hoisting will be done in the campus on Independence Day and Republic Day. All the students are invited to attend these official celebrations.

- End of Trimester: The end of Trimester coincides with the Trimester-Exams. At this time, students have completed all academic requirements for the academic year, including coursework, examinations, and any practical experiences such as internships.
- Summer Break: Students may enjoy a well-deserved break. The duration of the Summer Break may vary, but typically lasts for several weeks to allow individuals to rest, rejuvenate, and pursue personal interests before the start of the new academic year.
