<b>Quadrant-III (Assessment)</b>	<b>Quadrant-IV (Discussion Forum)</b>
Contains problems and solutions in various formats like multiple-choice questions, quizzes, assignments, etc.	Provides a platform for learners to raise doubts and get clarifications from course coordinators in near real-time.

### **Roles and Designations:**

- **National Coordinator (NC):** Institutions designated by the Ministry responsible for developing online courses for SWAYAM.
- **Course Coordinator (CC):** Subject Matter Experts responsible for developing specific online courses.
- **Host Institution:** Educational institutions offering MOOCs on SWAYAM, responsible for conducting examinations, evaluations, and issuing certificates.
- **Parent Institution:** Where learners are enrolled in a program and may opt for specific MOOCs on SWAYAM.

**Course Types:** Credit courses are taught for at least one semester as part of PG programs in Indian universities, while non-credit courses include awareness programs, continuing education programs, or specific skill sets.
