<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Independence Day and Republic Day Celebrations: Flag Hoisting will be done in the campus on Independence Day and Republic Day. All the students are invited to attend these official celebrations.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gandhi Jayanti Celebration: October 2 (Gandhi Jayanti) is also the foundation day for TIAS-CDL. Hence it is compulsory for all the students to attend this function.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Winter Break/Holidays: The Winter Break typically spans from December 24th to December 31st, providing students and faculty members with an opportunity to recharge before the start of the new year. During this time, administrative offices may operate on a reduced schedule or remain closed.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Industry Internship Period: The Industry Internship period begins immediately after the end of Trimester III. This allows students to gain practical work experience in relevant industries or organizations. The duration of the internship is for 8 to 12 weeks.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preparation Period for Exams: The period of almost 2 weeks is allocated for students to prepare for their examinations. During this time, students are encouraged to review course materials, revise concepts, and engage in self-study to ensure they are adequately prepared for their exams.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Examinations: Examinations are scheduled at the end of each Trimester. This period allows students to demonstrate their understanding of the course material and academic progress over the semester. Examination schedules are communicated well in advance to allow students to plan their study schedules accordingly.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • End of Trimester: The end of Trimester coincides with the Trimester-Exams. At this time, students complete all academic requirements for the academic year, including coursework, examinations, and any practical experiences such as internships.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Summer Break: Students may enjoy a well-deserved break. The duration of the Summer Break may vary, but typically lasts for several weeks to allow individuals to rest, rejuvenate, and pursue personal interests before the start of the new academic year.
